The Majjistral Action Group Foundation announces that it is launching the third call for proposals for Action 413.6 under Axis 4 LEADER.

The aim of this action is to offer support for capital expenditure to Art and Cultural Entities. This Action forms part of the MAGF's Local Development Strategy.

Only private legal entities (small and micro enterprises within the meaning of Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC) and registered NGOs which regularly operate within MAGF's territory, proposing projects within MAGF's territory and whose aim is that of offering a service directly related to arts and culture to the communities within MAGF's territory, can apply for this action. Beneficiaries will be granted 80% financial assistance should the proposed investment be selected.

This call will open on 12th January 2015 and will close on 12th February 2015, 12.00p.m. Applications must be submitted by hand to the offices of MAGF at 12, Triq it-Tullier, Attard ATD 1631 by the 12th February 2015, noon.
