The Majjistral Action Group Foundation announces that it is launching the second call for proposals for Action 413.6 under Axis 4 LEADER.

The aim of this action is to offer support for capital expenditures to Cultural and Art Entities.

This Action forms part of the MAGF's Local Development strategy. Only private legal entities (small and micro enterprises within the meaning of Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC) and NGOs operating within MAGF's territory, proposing projects within MAGF's territory and whose aim is that of offering a service that promotes arts and culture to the communities within MAGF's territory can apply for this action. Beneficiaries will be granted up to 80% financial assistance should the proposed investment be selected.
